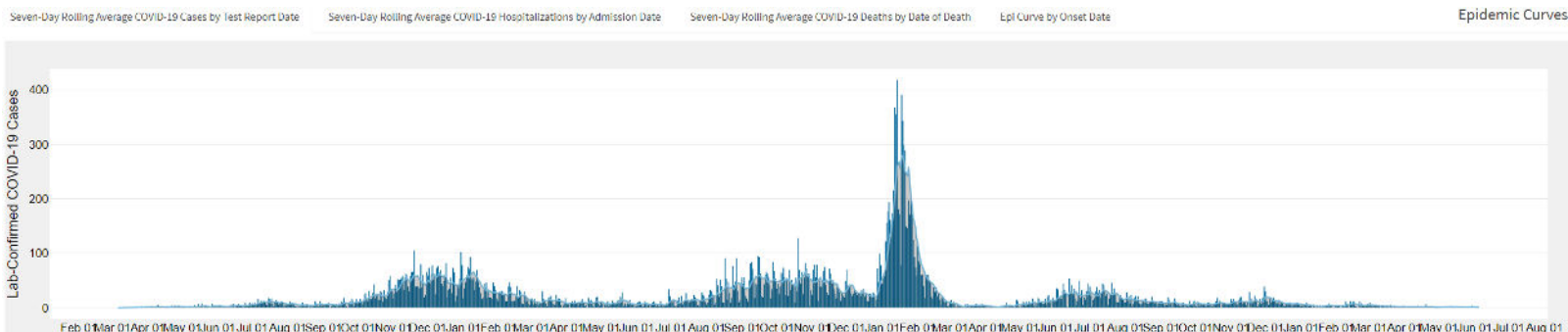
In **Tooele County, Utah**, the COVID-19 hospital admission level is **Low**.

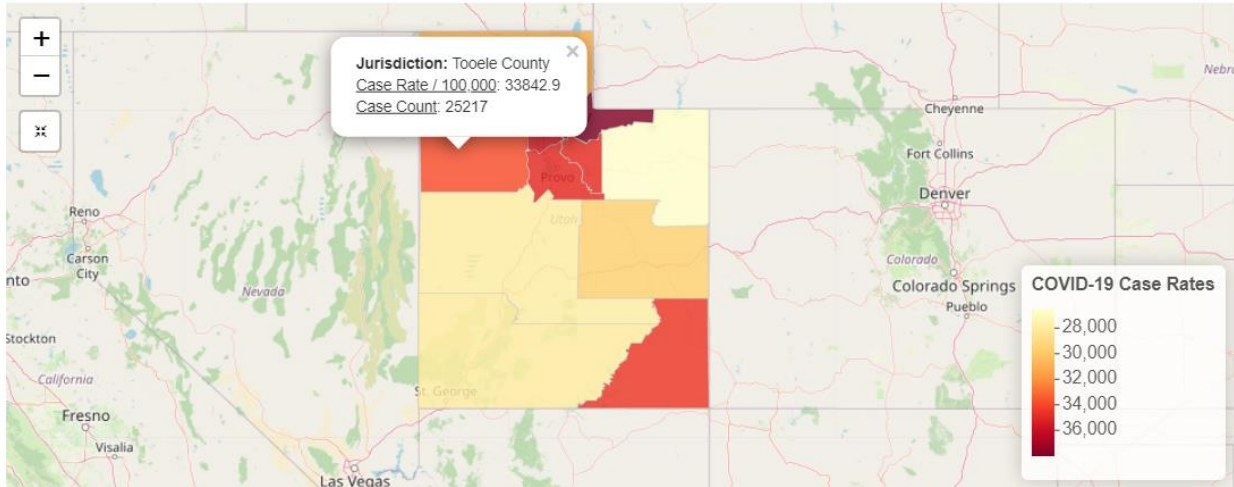

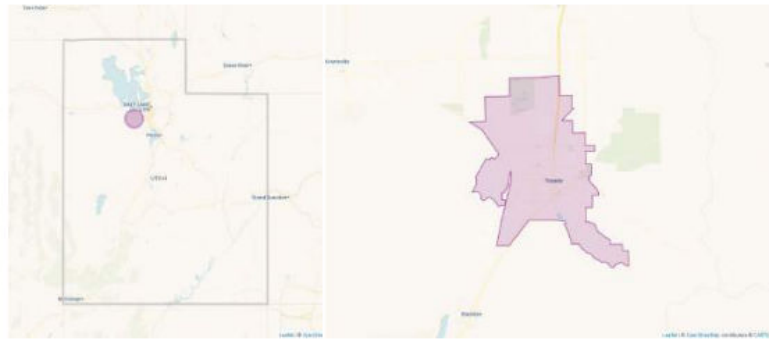
