## **The Top 5 Financial Scams Targeting Older Adults**

#### 1. The grandparent scam.

In this scam, fake grandchildren ask for help with car repairs, late rent, a medical emergency, or even to post bond. They pretend to be in distress. They may even beg the grandparent not to tell anyone.

#### 2. Financial services scam.

Scammers call, text, or send email messages that look and sound perfectly legitimate. They may claim that a checking or savings account has been compromised and ask for personal information, such as a password or Social Security number, to "secure" it. They may promise better rates or terms on a home loan. Or they may threaten arrest for unpaid medical bills—which may or may not exist.

#### 3. Tech support sacam.

A person's computer or phone screen will freeze or go blank. A pop-up message will appear with a phone number to dial for help. When the user calls it, the scammer on the other end will ask for permission to log on to the device remotely. This fake "tech support" representative also may demand a fee to repair the "issue."

#### 4. Government impersonation scam.

Callers pretend to be from the Internal Revenue Service (IRS), Social Security Administration, or Medicare. They threaten to arrest or deport the person who picks up the phone if they don't pay their "unpaid taxes". Or, they may threaten to cut off Social Security or Medicare benefits unless the person provides personal details. This information can then be used to commit identity theft.

#### 5. Romance scam.

Romance scammers tell all sorts of lies to steal your heart and money. You're looking to settle down. They're ready too. But there is one exception – you want to meet in real life, and they can't.

# Medicare's Open Enrollment Period

Open Enrollment runs October 15 through December 7 and is the time of year when you can make certain changes to your Medicare coverage. Medicare Advantage and Part D plans usually change each year. Make sure that your drugs will be covered next year and that your providers and pharmacies will be in network. Coverage begins Jan 1, 2026

## **Changes you can make during Medicare's Open Enrollment:**

- Joining a new Medicare Advantage plan or Part D prescription drug plan
- Switching from Original Medicare to Medicare Advantage
- Switching from Medicare Advantage to Original Medicare (with or without a Part D plan)

## Considerations when choosing a new plan

Ask yourself the following questions before choosing a Part D drug plan:

- Open the plan cover all the medications I take?
- Open Does the plan have restrictions on my drugs?
- How much will I pay for monthly premiums and the annual deductible?
- ? How much will I pay at the pharmacy (copay/coinsurance) for each drug I take?
- Is my pharmacy in the plan's preferred network? Can I fill my prescription by mail order?
- What is the plan's star rating?
- If I have other drug coverage, will the Medicare drug plan work with this coverage?

Ask yourself the following additional questions before choosing a Medicare Advantage plan:

- How much are the premiums, deductible, and coinsurance/copay amounts?
- What is the annual maximum out-of-pocket cost for the plan?
- What service area does the plan cover?
- What is the plan's star rating?

- Ooes the plan cover additional benefits not covered by Original Medicare?
- ? Are my doctors and hospitals in the plan's network?
- Will this plan affect any additional coverage I may have?

# **Protect Yourself from Marketing Violations**



During Open Enrollment, health insurance companies try to reach people in various ways, like television commercials, radio ads, events, mailings, phone calls, and texts. The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) has rules for marketing Medicare Advantage plans and Part D plans, though. These rules protect Medicare beneficiaries from aggressive or misleading marketing.

- Return to Original Medicare
